In the following years, we adopted waste diversion principles on many projects, winning awards for environmental excellence. And within a few more years, waste diversion was part of our standard operating procedures.

We've developed a strong LEED practice, built the most northerly Net Zero office building in the world, and are adept in Passivhaus, WELL Building Standard, and Embodied Carbon. But that's not enough. There is still a lot of work to do and we're ready for the challenge.

We're using innovation and technology to drive sustainable building practices. And we're always looking for partners who can challenge us to do better. We're also taking action in our offices to reduce our environmental footprint by using renewable energy and eliminating single use plastic.

For the past 15 years, our approach to sustainability has been driven by that same culture of excellence. Because for us, it's about more than just how we build; it's about what we leave behind for future generations. We've made the choice to recycle because it's the right thing to do, not because we have to do it.

VIRTUAL DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION Our work using Integrated Project Delivery (IPD) brings all key players to the table early in the design phase. Owners, general contractors, architects, and other consultants and trades collaborate to envision how a project will unfold. We identify and mitigate risks, and pinpoint opportunities to maximize value. Our IPD process allows us to share our progress in real time, saving our customers time, and millions of dollars. Part of what makes our IPD approach second to none is our use of lean construction principles and Virtual Design and Construction (VDC) techniques.

Customers should only pay for value they receive, not inefficiencies. That's why we embrace the concept of lean construction. It's about respecting our clients and the knowledge of our craft workers through continuous improvement. By constantly testing our approach and being proactive about the cost of wasted materials, time, and effort, we create more value and keep the work flowing seamlessly from one team to another.

On every site in every city and province we use the same pull planning, issue/action board, and daily meeting tools to manage our schedules and diverse teams. And when one of us finds a better way of working, we test, validate, and iterate.

What if all design and project teams could collaborate on virtual models to test ideas, optimize building performance, and coordinate work before even thinking about procurement or construction? No matter the size of a project, you'd deliver durable buildings more quickly with savings passed on to customers. That's exactly what our Virtual Design and Construction (VDC) team does. Once we've developed a model, we use VDC to identify and solve potential issues early on and prevent downtime and costly rework before it happens.

VDC enables a multi-trade prefabrication process that allows multiple building components to be constructed in an off-site, temperaturecontrolled environment. Projects with complex but repetitive elements such as bathrooms, clinical spaces and building envelope systems are well suited for off-site prefabrication.

Known as our "special ops" team, the Special Services Group (SSG) executes complex renovations and improvements to facilities where the stakes are high—from national brand roll-outs to medical and data centres where downtime could be catastrophic. 
